Walterdale Bridge Project update and site tour

The Walterdale Bridge Replacement Project has been a hub of activity all summer. Now that fall has arrived, media are invited to learn about the latest project milestones and tour the construction site.

Date: Tuesday, October 7, 2014

Time: 11 a.m.

Location: Northeast corner of Kinsmen Sports Centre parking lot ([view map](#))

Following a brief update on the project, members of the media will have the opportunity to take a tour of the construction site. There will be a safety overview before the tour.

NOTE:

- If you want to access the construction site for the tour, full personal protective equipment (PPE) will be required. This includes steel toed boots, hard hat, safety vest and protective eyewear. You must provide your own PPE.
- A **maximum of two** representatives from each media outlet will be allowed on site.
- Reminder that this is an active construction site. Visitors are required to follow safety guidelines and stay within the tour area at all times.
