Survey on Jasper Place plan open for feedback

Draft redevelopment plan will guide next 15-20 years

Residents are invited to have their say on the first draft of the City of Edmonton's Jasper Place Area Redevelopment Plan.

The draft plan is the result of two years of research and consultations regarding future redevelopment in four west-end neighbourhoods – Britannia Youngstown, Canora, Glenwood and West Jasper Place. Parts of the Stony Plain Road commercial corridor are also included.



The redevelopment plan will guide how land is used for housing, business and public amenities, ultimately helping manage growth and change over the next 15 to 20 years.

Anne Stevenson, the City planner leading the project, says there are exciting opportunities for the four neighbourhoods, which have seen significant investment through the City's Jasper Place Revitalization Strategy and will gain three new LRT stations with completion of the Valley Line.

Residents and business owners are encouraged to check out the draft plan at edmonton.ca/JasperPlaceARP and complete the <u>online survey</u>. Feedback will be considered in preparation of the second draft, due to be presented to the community in early 2015. All feedback will be summarized and shared with City Council.

The deadline to respond is October 31, 2014.
