Visit the City Market Downtown at City Hall

Starting Saturday, October 18, vendors from the popular <u>City Market Downtown</u> will be returning to City Hall to sell their wares. Open from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., the market features a selection of local produce, dairy, meat and eggs, and as well as handcrafted jewellery, delectable baking, unique fashions and accessories and original artwork.

For the second year, the City Market Downtown is partnering with <u>Kids in the Hall Bistro</u> to provide an enhanced local food



experience to market patrons. A concession cart will be on hand to take customer orders, and tables and chairs will be available to those wishing to eat while enjoying performances by many of the same entertainers that keep things lively on 104 Street. Those wanting a more formal dining experience can visit Kids in the Hall Bistro, whose menu will feature fresh City Market products.

On October 18 and 25 from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., children ages 5–12 years are invited to try the cardboard <u>Halloween Maze</u>. Entrance to the maze is free, however donations will be accepted on behalf of YESS (Youth Empowerment and Support Services). The first 25 kids through the maze will receive \$5 in market bucks.

Hosting the market at City Hall over the winter months supports local food producers and artisans, and is in line with the <u>Edmonton's Food and Urban Agriculture Strategy</u> as set out in Municipal Development Plan – The Way We Grow. It also supports the goals of Edmonton's <u>WinterCity Strategy</u> to make our city more livable, more inviting and more fun during the winter months.

The City Market Downtown will return to its outdoor location on 104 Street in May 2015.

Convenient and accessible, City Hall is easily reached by bus and LRT. Check the $\underline{\text{ETS website}}$ for route and schedule information. Underground parking at City Hall is \$0.50 an hour on Saturdays.
