Bike corrals back next spring

The City of Edmonton is packing up its bike corrals for the winter. Bike corrals provide parking for cyclists at six locations in Edmonton.

Bike corrals are part of a pilot program to create a more bikefriendly environment and to encourage cycling in high traffic areas. Bike corrals are on-street parking spots set aside for bikes instead of cars.



Bike corrals were set up in Old Strathcona and on 124th Street. The bike corrals next to Roots on Whyte, Next Act Pub, Strathcona Chapters and Tiramisu were popular and will be back again next year. City staff will also look at adding new locations next year.

An online survey from this summer showed that cyclists support bike corrals and prefer them near desirable locations even if they are located on a busy street. Based on feedback received last year, bike corrals for angled parking spots were redesigned and piloted this summer. Cyclists reported they were easier to get in and out of and safer to use.
