Project staff will present a bike boulevard and cycle track design option for each of the two routes. Some areas along the proposed routes require trade-offs. The City wants to hear from Edmontonians before finalizing the routes.

Developing bike routes supports the vision of the Transportation Master Plan, The Way We Move. It is one of the ways the City is providing more sustainable transportation options for Edmontonians.
