The City of Edmonton recently held three open houses about the proposed annexation of lands in Leduc County. Over 250 citizens from Edmonton and the Region attended the open houses, shared comments and asked questions. The City of Edmonton would like to thank those who attended the open houses.

If you did not have an opportunity to attend an open house, you can provide your feedback through an <u>online survey</u>.

The survey will run until December 5, 2014.

The City of Edmonton is proposing to annex land south of Edmonton in Leduc County to accommodate major growth demands. The City and Leduc County have begun the process of discussing the proposed annexation. The information rathered from the open



annexation. The information gathered from the open houses and the online survey will help inform the negotiating process between the City of Edmonton and Leduc County.

Annexation is a provincially legislated process of changing boundaries between municipalities. The process takes, on average, between two to five years.
