

20th annual ETS Stuff a Bus campaign begins

Edmonton Transit System (ETS) representatives and campaign partners have launched the [2014 ETS Stuff a Bus campaign](#). They're calling on Edmontonians to help drive out hunger between November 26 and November 29, 2014.

ETS volunteers will be collecting non-perishable food or cash donations at various transit centres and Save-On-Foods stores in Edmonton. This year's goal is to fill 15 buses with non-perishable food.

- Save-On-Foods; 9510 - 160 Avenue 10 a.m. - 7 p.m.

Friday, November 28

- Save-On-Foods; 3361 Calgary Trail NW 8 a.m. - 7 p.m.

Saturday, November 29

- **Main Collection Day** 8 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.
ETS volunteers and buses will be at all 13 Save-On-Foods stores in Edmonton

"This season, we invite all Edmontonians to take the ETS Stuff a Bus challenge in their community," said Charles Stolte, Branch Manager of ETS. "Every donation puts a Christmas twinkle in someone's eye and a warm meal on their table."

Since its inception in 1995, the City's Stuff a Bus campaign has collected more than 348,000 kilograms of food and over \$357,000 in cash to help people in need.
