Seasonal ETS route/schedule changes and Smart Bus

Enhanced Service on ETS routes

There will be minor changes to bus service starting **Sunday, November 30** as ETS makes seasonal adjustments to improve service reliability and connections between routes.

In addition, five new Edmonton Transit System (ETS) bus routes equipped with Smart Bus technology will begin providing enhanced service to customers. They are:

- Route 1 (Capilano Downtown West Edmonton Mall Transit Centre)
 Route 23 (Mill Woods Century Park Leger Transit Centre West Edmonton Mall Transit
- Centre)
 Route 30 (Mill Woods Century Park Leger Transit Centre Riverbend South Campus/Fort Edmonton)

 Route 75 (Mll Woods – Millgate)

 Route 89 (Meadows – Tamarack – Wild Rose)

Smart Bus uses Global Positioning System (GPS) technology to allow ETS customers to use the Internet and mobile devices to track their buses in real time, allowing for increased predictability, reliability and accessibility, as well as enhanced safety.

Customers traveling these routes will be able to track their buses in real-time using desktop computers or mobile devices at $\underline{ \text{TSLive.edmonton.ca}}.$
