Correction on number of violations seen with first seasonal parking ban

At a media event held December 1, the City of Edmonton mistakenly indicated that this year's first seasonal parking ban saw the lowest number of violations since the program began in 2011.

This year, bylaw officers issued 1,825 fines in two days, averaging 912 each day. This number is actually up from the first parking ban last winter. In November 2013, the first parking ban resulted in 1,362 tickets being issued over three days, for an average of 454 per day.

Higher violations can be attributed to more enforcement officers this season and a more targeted approach to enforcement in known problem areas of the city.

We continue to urge citizens to park responsibly during snow events while City crews work hard to remove the snow and ice.
