## Rundle Park Shinny Rink open for regular skating

The Rundle Park Shinny Outdoor Ice Rink is now open to the public for regular skating.

**Location:** 113 Avenue and 29 Street  
**Admission:** Free

Sticks and balls are not permitted on the ice at this time, as the shinny rink will be used by all skaters until the larger Rundle Park rink can be opened.



The shinny rink is east of the Rundle Park Family Centre. A rubber mat walkway connects the rink with the Family Centre's indoor skate change and warm-up area.
