City to present plan for 127 Street reconstruction

The City of Edmonton is hosting an open house to share the recommended concept plan for the reconstruction of 127 Street between 118 Avenue and Yellowhead Trail.

Date: Wednesday, January 28, 2015

Time: 5 – 8 p.m. (presentation at 6 p.m.)

Location: Prince Charles School (12325-127 Street)

The City of Edmonton has been consulting citizens about the reconstruction of 127 Street since June 2014. The January 28 meeting is the final opportunity for area residents, business owners and commuters to provide feedback on the plan for this route. The evening's presentation will outline how public input has been incorporated into design decisions and provide an overview of key details including number of lanes, lane widths and intersection improvements. A question and answer period will follow the presentation.

Road reconstruction along 127 Street is expected to begin during the 2016 construction season.
