## Crews ready for winter weather

The City of Edmonton's Transportation Services Department is prepared to handle the heavy snowfall that is expected for the region today and through the weekend.

Sanding is already underway in many areas and once snow begins to accumulate on roads, plows will be dispatched throughout the city. Contract graders are on standby and will be called in overnight to work on priority routes. Crews will focus their efforts on arterial roads, collector bus routes, bridge decks and river valley hills for the duration of the snowfall event. A decision regarding a potential seasonal parking ban and a subsequent neighbourhood blading cycle will be made once the snow stops and crews can assess conditions.
