ETS adds Smart Buses, makes seasonal route changes

Enhanced Service on ETS Routes

There will be minor changes to bus service starting Sunday, February 8 as ETS makes seasonal adjustments to improve service reliability and connections between routes. Routes affected are 78, 79, 100, 184 and 370.

In addition, five new Edmonton Transit System (ETS) bus routes equipped with Smart Bus technology will begin providing enhanced service to customers:

- Route 12 (Northgate - Wellington - Kingsway/RAH - Downtown)
- Route 36 (Century Park - South Campus/Fort Edmonton)
- Route 123 (Jasper Place - Westmount)
- Route 152 (Belvedere - Northgate)
- Route 154 (Belvedere - Northgate)

Smart Bus uses GPS technology to allow ETS customers to use mobile devices to track their buses in real time, leading to increased predictability, reliability and enhanced safety.

Customers traveling these routes will be able to track their buses using desktop computers or mobile devices at ETSLive.edmonton.ca or by downloading the ETS Live to Go® app from the Google Play or Apple iTunes stores.
