Seasonal Parking Ban Ends 6 p.m., Sunday, Feb 8/15

The seasonal parking ban that began on Friday, February 6 will be end effective **6 p.m. on Sunday, February 8**. Crews will be working up until 6 p.m. and enforcement will continue on seasonal parking ban routes until that time. After 6 p.m., residents who live on signed collector/bus routes will be able to park curbside again.

Crews will assess the level of the snow pack in neighbourhoods on Monday morning, and a decision will be made at that time whether or not a neighbourhood blading cycle is required.

Journalists interested in interviewing Bob Dunford, Director of Roadway Maintenance, Transportation Services, are reminded that there is a media availability on Monday morning to discuss snow clearing efforts, the level of compliance of the seasonal parking ban, and next steps.
