Tree Planting Program open for 2015 season

The City of Edmonton is excited to announce that the Root For Trees Community Tree Planting Program is now open to book 2015 tree planting experiences.

Date: May 11 – October 16 (tree planting season)

Location: Throughout Edmonton

In 2014, over 3500 volunteers planted over 40,000 trees and shrubs in Edmonton through the Root for Trees Program. Bookings are now being taken for the 2015 tree planting season. Group sizes, dates and timelines are available online and booking inquiries will be answered in the order they are received. The Community Tree Planting Program is open to all residents, community groups and corporations. Each planting group is accompanied by a City Planting Host and comes complete with all required equipment and supplies, including shovels, safety equipment, and, of course, trees. Self-guided tree planting events are also available for groups sizes of 12 people or less.
