Seasonal Parking Ban Ends 7 p.m., Monday, Feb 16/15

The seasonal parking ban that began on Sunday, February 15 will be end effective **7 p.m. on Monday, February 16**. Crews will be working up until 7 p.m. and enforcement will continue on seasonal parking ban routes until that time. After 7 p.m., residents who live on signed collector/bus routes will be able to park curbside again.

Neighbourhood blading will proceed as previously announced, with crews blading residential roads starting at 12:01 on Tuesday, February 17. Citizens can refer to the [blading schedule](#) to determine what date blading will take place in their areas. Collector/bus routes that have already been plowed are not bladed.

Journalists interested in interviewing Bob Dunford, Director of Roadway Maintenance, Transportation Services, are invited to a brief media availability on Tuesday morning to discuss snow clearing efforts and the level of compliance of the seasonal parking ban.
