## Proposed rezoning in the Oliver neighbourhood

Residents are invited to attend a public meeting to provide feedback on proposed rezoning in the Oliver neighbourhood to accommodate an apartment building with commercial/retail uses at street level.

**Date:** Wednesday, March 4, 2015

**Time:** 7 p.m.

**Location:** Robertson-Wesley United Church, 10209 -123 Street

The proposal seeks to rezone three properties, 12327-102 Avenue, and 10127 and 10131-124 Street. The rezoning will allow for the dismantling and reassembling of the west, north and south facades of the historic Buena Vista building, as well as the development of an 82-metre high (approximately 25-storey) apartment building with commercial/retail uses at street level. A maximum of 250 residential units and approximately 245 underground parking stalls for vehicles is proposed.

There will be opportunities to provide comments and feedback to the City and the applicant, which will be summarized in a report to City Council for consideration and a final decision on the rezoning.
