Want to learn about why urban planning is critical to the development of our city? Since 2006, more than 1,500 people have taken the City's Planning Academy courses to gain a better understanding of the planning and development process in Edmonton.

[Registration](#) for the 2015 Planning Academy spring course series is now open. Classes begin on March 24 and run through June 10, 2015.



The courses include three core courses: Land Use Planning: The Big Picture, Getting a Grip on Land Use Planning, Come Plan with Us: Using Your Voice, as well as four electives: Transportation, Transit-Oriented Development, Urban Design, and a new Infill course.

People are encouraged to register early because classes fill up fast. Registration for each course closes at midnight the day before the course is held.
