Daycamps available at two new locations

Clareview and the Meadows Community Recreation Centres are now among the City of Edmonton locations offering summer daycamps. Expanding into these new locations provides greater convenience for parents in Edmonton's northeast and southeast neighbourhoods.

The City of Edmonton offers Facilities Daycamps in many of Edmonton's best attractions, giving kids a unique chance to explore learning centres such as the Edmonton Valley Zoo, the Muttart Conservatory, Fort Edmonton Park, the City Arts Centre, John Janzen Nature Centre and Prince of Wales Armoury, as well as a number of recreation centres. For kids who love outdoor adventure, there are also daycamps in the River Valley.
