The ice is thin, don't fall in!

With temperatures warming up earlier this year, the City of Edmonton would like to remind people to use extreme caution on the ice surfaces around the city.

The ice cover on Edmonton stormwater lakes, ponds and rivers continues to recede with the spring thaw and are becoming increasingly dangerous for people and pets. Ice surfaces may appear thick enough to walk on but they are very hazardous.

Please remember that it is never safe to go on the ice of the North Saskatchewan River. Please obey the posted signs at stormwater lakes, ponds and creeks.

If you see someone or an animal fall through the ice, call 911 immediately. *Never* attempt a rescue yourself.
