Get Involved: Lansdowne and Lauderdale Neighbourhood **Reconstruction Open Houses**

The Lansdowne and Lauderdale neighbourhoods will be reconstructed in 2016 as part of the Building Great Neighbourhoods initiative. Residents and property owners are invited to learn about preliminary neighbourhood designs, construction timelines and local improvement processes. The City is looking for input on the designs and for suggestions to improve neighbourhood livability.

Neighbourhood Reconstruction is part of the City's Building Great Neighbourhoods initiative. Reconstruction invests money from the Neighbourhood Renewal taxlevy (1.5% for 2015) and utility rate dollars into renewing and replacing infrastructure. Reconstruction includes the renewal or replacement of storm and sanitary sewers, roadways, sidewalks, streetlights, curbs and gutters.
