Get Involved: Queen Mary Park Neighbourhood Reconstruction Open House

The Queen Mary Park neighbourhood will be reconstructed in 2016 as part of the Building Great Neighbourhoods initiative. Residents and property owners are invited to learn about the preliminary neighbourhood design, construction timelines and local improvement processes. The City is looking for input on the designs and for suggestions to improve neighbourhood livability.

Neighbourhood Reconstruction is part of the City's Building Great Neighbourhoods initiative. Reconstruction invests money from the Neighbourhood Renewal tax levy (1.5% for 2015) and utility rate dollars into renewing and replacing infrastructure and improving neighbourhood livability. Reconstruction includes the renewal or replacement of storm and sanitary sewers, roadways, sidewalks, streetlights, curbs and gutters.
