## Rezoning proposed in Jackson Heights to accommodate lowrise apartments

Residents are invited to attend an open house to provide feedback on proposed rezoning in the Jackson Heights neighbourhood to accommodate low-rise apartments.

The proposal seeks to rezone the property at 4461-50 Street from a Single Detached Residential Zone to a Site Specific Development Control Provision for the development of low-rise apartment housing, to a maximum of 175 units. The application also seeks to amend the Burnewood Neighbourhood Area Structure Plan to change the proposed future land use for the property from row housing to apartment housing.

The open house will be an opportunity to learn more about the proposal and provide feedback to the City and the applicant. Feedback will be summarized in a report to City Council before a final decision is made on the rezoning.
