Be Informed: 142 Street Rehabilitation Public Meeting

The City of Edmonton is hosting an information session prior to road rehabilitation beginning on 142 Street between 118 Avenue and Yellowhead Trail this spring. Area residents and business owners are invited to learn about construction and traffic impacts.

Date: Thursday, April 16, 2015 Time: 5:30 - 8:30 p.m. Location: Dovercourt School (13910 122 Avenue)

Construction will include:

- Road removal and replacementAnew shared-use path from 118 Avenue to 124 Avenue
- A new shared-use pain from 118 Avenue to 124 Avenue
 New sidewalk connections and bus stops
 New curbs and gutters, catch basins, manhole covers and drainage leads
 Replacement of commercial accesses, traffic signals and streetlights
 A new pedestrian/bus activated signal at the 124 Avenue intersection
 Curb ramps at all corners of the Yellowhead Trail intersection

142 Street from 118 Avenue to Yellowhead Trail is a four-lane, undivided arterial road, servicing both residential communities and industrial areas in northwest Edmonton. This work is the first stage of a long-term plan for the 142 Street corridor that was approved by City Council in June 2014.
