Learn more about downtown ETS service changes

The Edmonton Transit System invites transit users to a noon hour information session about coming service changes to downtown bus routes, schedules and stops. The changes are being made to accommodate downtown revitalization and development of the Valley Line LRT. Affected stops include those along 102 Avenue in front of the Stanley A MIner Library and Edmonton City Centre Mall.

Starting April 26, 2015

Routes 1, 2, 5, 52, 88, 109 and 309 have route and bus stop location changes and schedule adjustments.

Starting June 28, 2015

More routes will be affected with changes to routes, bus stop locations and schedules. Detailed information will be made available as the route changes are finalized.
