ETS service changes start Sunday, April 26

Starting Sunday, April 26, regular and permanent Edmonton Transit System (ETS) service adjustments will take effect across the city. Eight routes into the Downtown are being adjusted with changes to schedules and bus stop locations.

Routes 1, 2, 5, 52, 88, 109, 135 and 309 are affected. These changes will impact bus stops along 102 Avenue near Edmonton City Centre Mall, Don Wheaton YMCA Commerce Place, Churchill Square, Stanley A Miner Library, and Winspear Centre.

These service adjustments are necessary to support the lane and road closures needed to accommodate construction of Rogers Place Arena, new downtown office buildings and preparations for the Valley Line LRT along 102 Avenue. In late June, additional changes to 40 more routes are planned. The ETS service changes are happening in stages in order to minimize commuter disruption.

Regular seasonal changes also go into effect April 26. These include starting our shuttle to the Valley Zoo and Fort Edmonton Park, as well as reduced service to post-secondary institutions.
