Call for feedback on winter parking pilot

Residents of Wards 1 and 9 whose neighbourhoods were part of the Winter Parking Ban Pilot this past winter are invited to provide their feedback to the City.

From November 1, 2014 until March 15, 2015, parking was restricted to one side of the street in West Jasper Place, Crestwood, Henderson Estates and Haddow. In exchange for reduced parking, roads were plowed down as close to bare pavement as possible rather than maintained at a 5 cm snowpack. The larger windrows that were created by the plowing were stacked against the side of the street where parking had been banned.

The feedback provided by citizens will be used to determine whether or not banning parking on one side of the street resulted in an improved level of service and allowed better access and navigation on residential roads. The City will determine if a similar practice will be used in other neighbourhoods in the future.

Residents of the pilot neighbourhoods are asked to visit the Edmonton Insight Community and fill out the [survey](#) on the winter parking pilot. Feedback will be gathered until May 15, and both the survey results and the operational outcomes will be presented at community meetings in June.
