Groat Road closed this weekend

Removal of damaged girders continues

Groat Road will be completely closed to traffic between 107 Avenue and River Valley Road beginning at 7:30 p.m. on Friday, May 8 until 6 a.m. on Monday, May 11.

The road is being closed to allow for continuing work on the 102 Avenue Bridge Replacement Project. Several of the girders were damaged during installation on March 16. The contractor has successfully removed girders #6 and #7 and plans to remove girders #4 and #5 this weekend. Girders #4, #5 and #6 will be assessed by a team of engineers at the manufacturer's facility to determine whether they can be repaired or must be replaced.

While Groat Road is closed to traffic, parking will be banned along the east side of 116 Street between 100 Avenue and Jasper Avenue, and on 109 Street between 99 Avenue and 102 Avenue. There will be no access to the multi-use path adjacent to Groat Road during the closures.

The City appreciates the continued patience and understanding of Edmonton residents as we work to resolve the 102 Avenue Bridge situation.
