## Final concept designs for bike routes revealed

The City of Edmonton invites citizens to attend public workshops to review final design plans for the 102 Avenue and the 83 Avenue bike routes.

### 102 Avenue Bike Route

City staff will present final concept plans for the protected bike lanes and landscaping options to enhance each of the routes. There will be time for one-on-one discussions after the presentation. The project team will gather your feedback on the plans and the aesthetic options.

Construction of the 102 Avenue and 83 Avenue bike routes is anticipated to begin in 2016.

Developing cycling infrastructures fulfills the vision of the Transportation Master Plan, *The Way We Move*, and it is one of the ways the City is providing more sustainable transportation options for Edmontonians.
