Weekend closure of Groat Road

Fewer closures will be required in months ahead

As work continues on the 102 Avenue Bridge Replacement Project, Groat Road between 107 Avenue and River Valley Road will be closed from 6 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturday, May 30 as surveys are carried out on the structure.

Although additional overnight and weekend closures will still be required as crews continue work on the project, the pending installation of a temporary deck will give the contractor the chance to do more work from above the road. This will result in fewer total closures of Groat Road over the next several months and will reduce the inconvenience to motorists who use that route.

The next anticipated closure for Groat Road between 107 Avenue and River Valley Road is from 7:30 p.m. Friday, June 12 until 6 a.m. Monday, June 15 (to install access platforms and deck forms).

During the closures, parking will be prohibited on the east side of 116 Street, between 100 Avenue and Jasper Avenue, on both sides of 109 Street from the High Level Bridge to 104 Avenue, and 105 Street from 100 Avenue to 104 Avenue.

The City of Edmonton greatly appreciates the patience of citizens as we continue work on this essential piece of our city's transportation infrastructure.
