## Residents invited to attend meetings on winter parking pilot

Residents of Crestwood, West Jasper Place, Henderson and Haddow are invited to attend community engagement meetings on the results of the Winter Parking Ban Pilot that took place in their neighbourhoods from November 2014 to March 2015.

Representatives from Roadway Maintenance will be presenting both the operational results and the public feedback received through the course of the pilot. Members of each community will have an opportunity to speak to Roadway staff, and to provide further feedback and ideas about how to improve residential winter roadway maintenance.

The feedback provided by citizens will be used to determine whether or not banning parking on one side of the street resulted in an improved level of service and allowed better access and navigation on residential roads. The opinions and information shared will be critical in helping the City determine if similar practices will be used in other neighbourhoods in the future or if a different approach is warranted.
