Detour to access the Edmonton Waste Management Centre

Due to repairs of the railway tracks at Meridian Street and Hayter Road north of Yellowhead Trail, residents are asked to use an <u>alternative route</u> to access the Edmonton Waste Management Centre (EWMC) on **Saturday, June 20 and Sunday, June 21**.

To access the site, take Yellowhead Trail and exit on Sherwood Drive/Range Road 232 north and follow the detour signs.



As an alternative to traveling to the EVMC, residents are reminded that the new Kennedale Eco Station in northeast Edmonton is now open. Located at 5355-127 Avenue, this Eco Station is a comprehensive waste drop-off facility where residents can bring many types of waste.
