Trolley bridge struck, 97 Avenue and 109 Street

Inspection to take place pending removal of the overheight vehicle

During the morning commute on Tuesday, June 30, a tractor trailer unit travelling west on 97 Avenue at 109 Street struck the trolley bridge above (north of the High Level Bridge). Work is currently underway to remove the vehicle. Once the vehicle is removed, Transportation Services engineers will carry out an inspection of the trolley bridge.

Members of the media are invited to speak with Shiraz Kanji, Bridge Engineer, Roadway Maintenance, Transportation Operations, about the warning system currently in place to prevent collisions by overheight trucks and how the City ensures that bridges that have been hit remain structurally sound.
