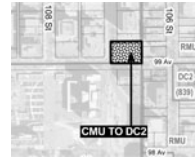


Public meeting for proposed downtown highrise

Residents are invited to provide feedback on a proposed 30 storey, high-density residential tower at 9901 107 Street NW.

The proposed tower will have a maximum of 235 units and 148 underground parking stalls as well as commercial and retail at street level. The application also proposes amendments to the Edmonton Zoning Bylaw to reflect the proposed highrise. Amendments would include the downtown zoning map, downtown maximum floor area ratio and downtown maximum height map.

The meeting is an opportunity to learn more about the proposal and provide your feedback to the City and applicant. Feedback will be summarized in a report to City Council before they make a decision on the application.
