City seeks public input on distances between liquor stores

The City is looking for input on [proposed changes](#) to the regulations in the Zoning Bylaw that govern the distance between liquor stores. Feedback is being accepted through an [online survey](#) that will remain open until July 30, 2015.

The existing Zoning Bylaw regulations require liquor stores to be located at least 500 metres away from each other (equivalent of approximately 2.5 downtown city blocks). The proposed [draft amendments](#) seek to relax this distance requirement in big box shopping areas, while maintaining the ability to control the concentration of liquor stores along established commercial shopping corridors such as Stony Plain Road, Whyte Avenue and Jasper Avenue.
