ETS adds service for One Direction concert

Edmonton Transit System is providing extra service to get people to and from the One Direction concert at Commonwealth Stadium tonight. With increased demands for LRT service due to K-Days and other special events, ETS is encouraging people to leave plenty of extra time and to consider taking a Park and Ride bus.

- Special Event Park and Ride is available from six pick-up locations, Burns, Calder or Davies City Lots and Mill Woods Town Centre, Kingsway Mall, and the Lewis Farms Transit Centre. Park and Ride service starts at 5 p.m. LRT peak service is extended.
- Regular transit fare (\$3.20 or \$6.40 for adult roundtrip) apply. Buses leave approximately every 10 minutes from each lot. Regular bus service will also get concert-goers there via routes 2, 120 and 127.

To support parents who are not attending the show but plan to wait for their children, The Commonwealth Community Recreation Centre will remain open for the duration of the event with a designated waiting lounge located in the facility's gymnasium.
