Proposed rezoning for a low-rise apartment in Bonnie Doon

Residents are invited to an open house to provide feedback on a proposal to rezone the property at 9103 and 9107 84 Avenue. The proposed rezoning will allow for a 15-metre low-rise apartment building with street-level commercial/retail uses facing 91 Street, as well as two, 10-metre row houses facing 84 Avenue.

The proposed development will have a maximum of 12 residential units and up to 14 underground parking spaces. Possible permitted ground-floor commercial uses may include small retail stores, coffee shops and similar food services, personal service shops, and offices.

The open house will be an opportunity to learn more about the proposed rezoning and provide feedback to the City and the applicant, Newstudio Architecture. Feedback will be summarized in a report to City Council before a final decision is made on the rezoning.
