City seeks input on McKernan-Belgravia land development process

Residents in McKernan and Belgravia are invited to provide input on how the City can make future land use and zoning decisions in their neighbourhood a more collaborative process.

Feedback may be provided through an <u>online survey</u> available at <u>edmonton.ca/McKernanBelgraviaARP</u>. The survey will remain open until August 21, 2015.



Feedback collected from the survey will be used to help guide implementation of the McKernan-Belgravia Station Area Redevelopment Plan. The plan sets out the vision for land use and zoning decisions in McKernan and Belgravia over the next 25 years. Its goal is to enhance and strengthen the local character of these neighbourhoods, while capitalizing on the presence of the McKernan/Belgravia LRT Station through Transit Oriented Development and encouraging infill.
