## Wireless Edmonton renamed Open WiFi

In a continuous effort to support the City's commitment of becoming an open and connected city, Wireless Edmonton has been renamed Open WiFi. Open WiFi provides free Internet access at some of the City's publicly accessible facilities.

Users can access the free public WFI by selecting Open WFI from the list of wireless networks from their devices. Currently more than 14,000 devices connect to Wireless Edmonton everyweek, with 4,500 users signed in during peak periods.

The City is not a provider of municipal broadband and does not participate in the market in this way. This free service to the public allows Edmontonians and visitors to our city to stay connected, while also serving limited business needs for City employees and visitors that would otherwise not be available.
