## Get the Lay of the Land

Interested in a behind the scenes look at the Citlys urban planning process? <u>Registration</u> for the fall 2015 Planning Academy course series is now open. Classes begin on September 19 and run through November 25, 2015.

The schedule includes three core courses: Land Use Planning: The Big Picture, Getting a Grip on Land Use Planning, Come Plan with Us: Using Your Voice, as well as four electives: Transportation, Transit-Oriented Development, Urban Design, and an Infill course.

Participants are encouraged to register early, as classes fill up fast. Registration for each course closes at midnight the day before the course is held.

Planning Academy is a series of classes offered twice a year to provide a better understanding of the planning and development process in Edmonton. Since 2006, more than 1,500 people have taken the City's Planning Academy courses to learn more about how a great city is built, and how they can become involved in the process.
