Interested in a behind the scenes look at the City's urban planning process? [Registration](#) for the fall 2015 Planning Academy course series is now open. Classes begin on September 19 and run through November 25, 2015.

The schedule includes three core courses: Land Use Planning: The Big Picture, Getting a Grip on Land Use Planning, Come Plan with Us: Using Your Voice, as well as four electives: Transportation, Transit-Oriented Development, Urban Design, and an Infill course.

Participants are encouraged to [register](#) early, as classes fill up fast. Registration for each course closes at midnight the day before the course is held.

Planning Academy is a series of classes offered twice a year to provide a better understanding of the planning and development process in Edmonton. Since 2006, more than 1,500 people have taken the City's Planning Academy courses to learn more about how a great city is built, and how they can become involved in the process.
