

ETS Fall Service Changes start Sunday

Starting Sunday, September 6, Edmonton Transit System is restoring full seasonal bus service, in addition to adding Late Night Owl Service and opening the Metro Line LRT. A reminder that the Metro Line and the Capital Line share some track, so train schedules are changing. LRT riders on both lines are reminded to check the destination sign on the train as they board and to allow extra time to make connections.

On Labour Day Monday, September 7, Downtown buses on Routes 1, 2, 3, 5, 7, 8, 9, 15, 57, 86, 100, 130, 140, 151, 201 will detour to accommodate the Tour of Alberta. Due to the statutory holiday, buses and LRT will be operate on a Sunday service schedule.

Also, starting Tuesday, September 8, another 10 new and extended routes (25, 26, 77, 95, 124, 157, 164, 166, 168, and 195) will start service in various communities. Also, midday frequency will be increased to every 15 minutes on the express Route 15 between Milgate Transit Centre and NAIT.
