

City recognized as leader for infill roadmap

The City of Edmonton is one of only four winners recognized for leadership in innovation and planning at the [Alberta Professional Planners Institute \(APPI\) awards](#) ceremony on September 17, 2015.

The [APPI award](#) went to [Edmonton's Infill Roadmap](#), a work plan to advance residential infill over two years. It was developed with citizen and stakeholder engagement to create 23 actions to improve communication, remove barriers for building infill and support infill development in our city.

"Infill is a key part of Edmonton's growth strategy to accommodate our growing population," said Peter Ohm, branch manager of urban planning and environment. "It's an honour that our city's innovation and creativity were recognized through the 2015 Alberta Professional Planners Institute Awards."

The Institute recognizes exemplary plans and projects that significantly contribute to the livability of communities in Alberta, the Northwest Territories and Nunavut. The 2015 awards ceremony takes place at the APPI conference luncheon here in Edmonton.
