

Art in the Heart of Downtown

Nuit Blanche Edmonton is a free, late-night contemporary art event that will take place in Downtown Edmonton. Featuring 31 artworks from local and international artists, Nuit Blanche Edmonton is for both the art-sawy and the art-skeptical alike. These art installations will be located throughout the downtown core — most of them within a five-minute walking distance of Sir Winston Churchill Square. This familyfriendly event will last one night only, so don't miss it!

The City will be lighting up the <u>Downtown Big E</u> as part of Nuit Blanche. Visitors will be able to take photos with this structure, which will be located south of the fountain on the City Hall Plaza.

The <u>High Level Bridge lights</u> will feature a special <u>transitory public art program</u> commissioned by the Edmonton Arts Council for Nuit Blanche. The bridge will be lit for the duration of the event.

Downtown Road Closures

The following road closures will be in effect from noon on Saturday, September 26 until 7 a.m. on Sunday, September 27:

- 104 Avenue in front of CN Tower
- 99 Street, from 101 A venue (Centennial Plaza) to the City Hall parkade. City Hall parkade will be accessible by taking 103A Avenue to 99 Street
- 100A Street (Rice Howard Way) from 102 Avenue to 101A Avenue, and from the Tilden parkade located south of 101A Avenue to Jasper Avenue
- 102 Avenue from 101 Street to 97 Street west of the Canada Place parkade

Limited Pedway Access

The east pedways to Edmonton City Centre that span over 102A Avenue and connect the mall with the parkade will be programmed with art installations, so access will be limited. This will remain in effect until Sunday, September 27 at 7 a.m.

Nuit Blanche ETS Service

On Saturday, September 26 from 7 p.m. until 4 a.m. Sunday, September 27, <u>Late Night Owl Service</u> will have extended hours on routes 1, 8, 9, and 512 (LRT replacement service) for Nuit Blanche.

Extended late-night service will continue every 30 minutes until the regular Sundaybus and LRT service starts on Sunday morning.

Regular transit fares apply.

Please note: Route 4 travelling from Lewis Farms to Capilano will not be extended beyond current Late Night Owl Service schedule.
