



Buses replace LRT service October 3 and 4, 2015

LRT service will be affected this weekend due to routine maintenance along the Capital Line. Starting Saturday, October 3 at 9:30 p.m., Metro Line trains will only run between NAIT and Churchill stations. Transfers between the two lines will only be possible at Churchill station.

On Sunday, October 4, both the Metro and Capital Lines will be affected. LRT passenger service between Clareview and Churchill stations will be suspended from start of service. Regular LRT service on both lines will be restored by noon on Sunday, October 4.

Buses marked "LRT replacement service" will provide shuttles between each of the north LRT stations and into Downtown until 12:30 p.m. at a 7/8 minute frequency.

Crews are performing routine maintenance, including lighting adjustments and rail maintenance. LRT service adjustments are required to complete work in a safe and timely manner.
