

New access route to Edmonton Waste Management Centre

Anyone heading to the Edmonton Waste Management Centre (EWMC) should be aware of changes for getting to the centre.

Residents and commercial businesses can now travel to the EWMC using a new overpass that can be accessed from Anthony Henday Drive and eastbound Yellowhead Trail. The opening of the overpass coincides with a new main entrance and address for the EWMC, 250 Aurum Road. The entrance at 13111 Meridian Street is now closed.



The overpass bypasses train tracks that previously caused delays in getting to the site. However, Edmontonians are advised that construction delays and detours will still occur until work on the northeast section of the Anthony Henday is completed.

The Edmonton Waste Management Centre is a unique collection of advanced waste processing and research facilities and it's an integral part of Edmonton's sustainable approach to waste management.
