Beechmount Cemetery, one of Edmonton's seven municipal cemeteries, is honoured to be the host location for the fifth annual No Stone Left Alone Veterans' Week event. No Stone Left Alone is a memorial foundation that educates Canadians about the sacrifices of veterans, and arranges for poppies to be placed on headstones in Fields of Honour.

On Remembrance Day, there will be no ceremonies at Edmonton municipal cemeteries, so that they may serve as calm and quiet places for reflection. The public is encouraged to visit the Veterans Affairs Canada website for a list of local ceremonies.
