

Proposed rezoning in McConachie for new residential development

Residents are invited to an open house to discuss the proposed rezoning of several properties in the north portion of the McConachie neighbourhood, located south of Anthony Henday Drive and east of 66 Street NW.

Date: Wednesday, November 25, 2015

Time: 6 - 8 p.m.

Location: The Slovenian Canadian Association Hall

16703 - 66 Street NW

The proposed rezoning of the properties from agricultural to residential and public utility uses would allow for the development of single family, semi-detached, and apartment housing, as well as a stormwater management facility.

The new development would also require amendments to the McConachie Neighbourhood Structure Plan to change the proposed future land use for the site from low density to medium density residential uses, and reconfigure the collector roadway in the north portion of the neighbourhood.

The open house is an opportunity to learn more about the proposal and provide feedback to the City and development applicant, which will be summarized in a report to city council for a final decision on the rezoning.
