



Queen Elizabeth II Highway/41 Avenue interchange opens

At 9 a.m. on Thursday, November 19, the interchange at Queen Elizabeth II Highway and 41 Avenue SW will open to traffic.

The \$205 million project, which began in summer 2013, helps meet current and future traffic demand in the Capital Region and facilitates travel both within Alberta and inter-provincially.

The project includes:

- construction of a new interchange on QEII Highway and 41 Avenue SW, including a grade separation of the new Canadian Pacific Railway intermodal facility
- realignment of QEII Highway from south of 41 Avenue SW to Ellerslie Road
- creation of a bridge crossing Blackmud Creek
- upgrading of 41 Avenue SW to handle the traffic generated from the new intermodal terminal

An official grand opening event for the interchange will take place in December.
