



City to share plans for 122 Avenue

The City of Edmonton is hosting an open house to share a draft concept plan with design options and to gather the public's feedback on 122 Avenue from 107 Street to Fort Road.

Date: Tuesday, November 24, 2015
Time: 4:30 – 8 p.m. (presentations at 5 p.m. and 6:30 p.m.)
Location: Delton Community Hall, 12325 – 88 Street

The purpose of this concept planning study is to update the roadway to meet the needs of current and future users, and to ensure a consistent road design across the five neighbourhoods along the corridor.

This meeting is an opportunity for area residents and business owners to learn how their previous input was used to develop the draft concept plan as it addresses community concerns about speeding, pedestrian safety, intersection congestion and parking.

City staff will be on hand to gather feedback on the plans and to answer any questions. Anyone who is unable to attend can share their thoughts through an online survey available between November 24 and December 8.

Reconstruction of 122 Avenue is planned for 2017.
